Facility:

- Eight lane, 25-yard competition course
- Water depth: The minimum water depth, measured in accordance with Article 103.2.3, is seven feet at the start end and the turn end is 18 feet measured for a distance of one meter to five meters from both end walls.
- The racing course *has not* been certified in accordance with Article 104.2.2C(4)
- DAKTRONICS starting and timing systems
- Scoreboard with full heat and event display
- Six constantly available warm-up / cool-down lanes
- Adequate free parking adjacent to the pool
- On-deck stadium seating for 1000
- Concessions and swim shop in the lobby
- Food from outside sources is not permitted in the Aquatic Center
- Chairs are not permitted in the facility
- Deck changing is prohibited!

Rules: •The 2018 - 2019 National Federation Swimming and Diving Rules will govern this meet

Cell phone

Restrictions:

- The presence and / or use of cell phones, and / or any other equipment capable of producing audio recordings, photographic or video images in locker rooms, rest rooms, changing areas or anywhere behind the starting blocks is strictly and specifically prohibited at all times
- There are no exceptions to these prohibitions
- Violators are subject to disqualification from the meet, disbarment from the facility and arrest

Swimmer Photographs And Videos:

- There may be one or more photographers and / or videographers on deck at this meet.
 - Each participating school is allowed two photographers / videographers on deck during competition.
- In the event such personnel are present, parents or guardians of swimmers under the age of 18 who do not wish to have photos or videos of their athletes made, are required to contact the Meet Director prior to the beginning of warm-ups.
- Photographers and videographers are strongly encouraged to stay out of the area immediately behind the starting blocks, but if present, they are specifically prohibited from taking shots during the start phase of any race.

Entry

Restrictions:

- This meet is open to all Parochial and Private High Schools
- Each swimmer may enter four events, no more than two of which may be individual events
- No school may enter more than four swimmers in any single individual event

- Format:**
- Timed Finals
 - Standard High School events
 - No diving
 - The National Federation no-recall false start procedure will be in use
 - Fly-over starts MAY be in use for events where appropriate at the discretion of the Meet Referee
 - Fifteen minute break after the 50-yard freestyle
 - Senior recognition
 - Five minute breaks after the 200-yard medley relays and the 100-yard breaststrokes
 - Unlimited individual entries are permitted in the 50- and 100-yard freestyles
 - A, B, and C teams are permitted in the 200-yard medley and freestyle relays
 - ONLY A and B teams are permitted in the 400-yard freestyle relays

- Relays:**
- Only the four (4) swimmers declared on the front of the relay card are permitted to report to the blocks and compete.
 - If the swimmers are to be correctly noted in the Final Results, the order of swimming must also be specified.
 - COACHES' PLEASE TAKE SPECIAL NOTE: Teams who fail to meet the following relay card submission time constraints will be scratched from the respective events!
There can be no exceptions or appeals!
 - Relay cards for the 200-yard Medley Relay must be turned in to the Official Scorer not later than thirty (30) minutes prior to the scheduled start of the meet.
 - Relay cards for the 200-yard Free Relay must be turned in to the Official Scorer not later than the start of the men's 500-yard freestyle.
 - Relay cards for the 400-yard Free Relay must be turned in to the Official Scorer not later than the start of the men's 100-yard backstroke.
 - Once relay cards have been turned in to the Official Scorer, no changes will be permitted and post-meet corrections cannot be made, illness and injury excepted.

- Qualifying Times:**
- There are minimum Qualifying Times on six (6) events, three girls and three boys
 - Swimmers entering any one of the six events **must** at some time (lifetime best) have achieved the indicated time

- Entry Procedures**
- Entries may be submitted ONLY by Hy-Tek Commlink file
 - Hard copy must accompany
 - Each entry must include the swimmer's full name, swimmers school affiliation grade, and a seedtime
 - Entries received without a seedtime will be rejected
 - There is an HYV File posted on the High School Dual Plus Calendar and Results Page of the AAAA Web Site, which contains the meet setup and time standards. (www.aaaa-sa.org)

- Individual swimmers or relay teams are not considered to be officially entered into an event until actually stepping up on the block or into the water, as the case may be, i.e., there is no penalty for scratching or being a NO SHOW.
