- Cell phone Restrictions:**
- The presence and / or use of cell phones, or any other equipment capable of producing audio recordings, photographic or video images in locker rooms, rest rooms or changing areas is strictly and specifically prohibited at all times
  - There are no exceptions to this prohibition
  - Violators are subject to disqualification from the meet, disbarment from the facility and arrest

- Swimmer Photographs And Videos:**
- There may be one or more photographers and / or videographers on deck at this meet.
  - In the event such personnel are present, parents or guardians of swimmers under the age of 18 who do not wish to have photos or videos of their athletes made, are required to contact the Meet Director prior to the beginning of warm-ups.

- Meet Format:**
- AAHSSL Teams competing in timed final competition
  - Standard and modified high school individual events
  - Maximum (slower than) times for all events
  - Minimum (faster than) qualifying times for six (6) events
  - The Federation Whistle Start Procedure will be in use
  - The Federation No-recall False Start Procedure will be in use
  - Order of events on page four (4)
  - Pre-seeded
  - Fly-over starts will be used, except for the backstroke and relay events
  - Breaks will be taken only at the points noted in the Order of Events on four (4)

**Entry**

- Restrictions:**
- This meet is open to all public and private high school teams who are current (2018-2019) members of the AAHSSL.
  - Individual swimmers may enter a maximum of five (5) events, three of which may be individual events
  - No limit on the number of individual entries per team, per individual event
  - ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT A SEED TIME WILL NOT BE ENTERED INTO THE MEET
  - Teams may enter an "A," a "B," and a "C" relay
  - Only the fastest relay from each team will score

**Qualifying**

**Times:**

- There are maximum qualifying times (2016 South Zone TISCA) for all events, please see page four (4)
- Swimmers must have never achieved the maximum cut-off time for each of those events they choose to enter.
- There are minimum qualifying times on six (6) events, three girls and three boys, please see four (4)
- Entry times may be challenged
- Swimmers must have at some time (lifetime best) achieved the minimum cut-off time for each of those events they choose to enter.
  - If a challenge results in an entry time being declared invalid, the swimmer will be disqualified from further participation in the meet
- Any team accumulating three (3) invalid entries will be banned from further participation in the meet and their school's principal notified

**Rules:**

- The 2018 - 2019 National Federation of State High School Association Swimming and Diving Rules will apply
- Swimmers will not be considered to be officially entered into the meet until actually stepping up on the starting platform or into the water, i.e., there will be no penalty for scratches or no-shows.
- Nominal interval of 30 seconds between races

**Procedures:**

- Entries may be made ONLY via HY-TEK Commlink File
- Hard copy MUST accompany
- An "HYV" File for Team Manager is available on the High School Invitational Meet Calendar Page of the AAAA Web Site ([www.aaaa-sa.org](http://www.aaaa-sa.org))

- Athletes WILL NOT be entered into the Meet Manager Database until the Meet Entry Report (hard copy) is received as an attachment to the e-mail or hand-delivered entries and all fees are paid.
- Under no circumstances will entries be accepted via FAX
- Please do not assume your entries have been received without confirmation

  - Please include the name of the meet on the check
  - All entry fees must be paid prior to the start of the meet; if payment will be delayed, school must notify and make arrangements with the Meet Director prior to the day of the meet
  - Teams that have not paid their entry fees or made satisfactory arrangements with the Meet Director will not be allowed to participate in the meet.
  - No late or deck entries will be permitted

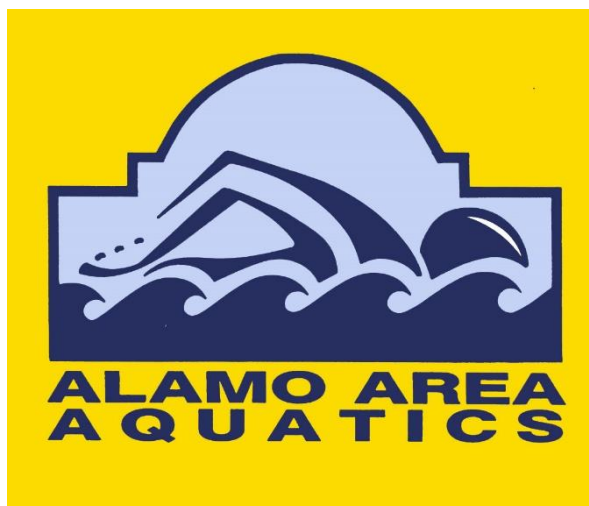

## Athlete, Coach, Official Access

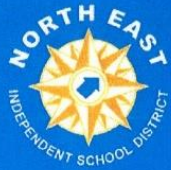
### and Parking:

### PROHIBITED ITEMS INCLUDE, BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO:

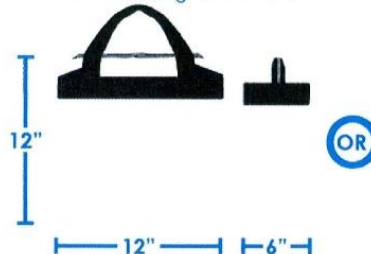
- All purses, bags or containers larger than a small clutch bag

## Approved Bags

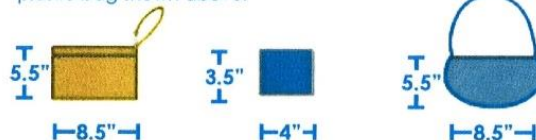
**CLEAR TOTE**  
Plastic, vinyl or PVC –  
not exceeding 12" x 6" x 12"

**PLASTIC STORAGE BAG**  
Clear, one (1) gallon,  
re-sealable



### SMALL CLUTCH PURSE

Approximately the size of your hand, but absolutely no larger than 5.5" x 8.5" (see our small guide sheet) with or without a handle or strap. Can be carried separately or within an approved plastic bag shown above.



To enhance public safety, Blossom Athletic Center has modified its security policy by limiting the size and style of bags allowed into events.

An exception will be made for medically necessary items after proper inspection at a gate designated for this purpose.  
Please limit the number of items you bring to the stadium on event days.

**These "Clear Bags" restrictions DO NOT apply to Athletes, Coaches or Officials; all of whom are expected to enter and exit the building via the large double doors behind the starting blocks!**
