•The Bill Walker Pool opened in October of 2019 and is part of the North East School District's Blossom Athletic Center and is also known as the North East Stadium

•It is an indoor, 10-lane facility with off-deck spectator seating for 800

•In its several configurations there may be two (2) 25-yard (SCY) racing courses, one 25-meter (SCM) racing course, or one 50-meter (LCM) racing course

• <u>Each</u> of the possible racing courses has been professionally certified IAW Article 104.2.2C(4) and the data on file with USA Swimming

•This competition will be conducted in the **SOUTH** ♥ 25-yard Pool

•2.25-meters (7.5-ft) wide lanes

•Water depth:

•One-meter from start end
•One-meter from turn end

2.35m (7.7ft)
•Five-meters from start end
•One-meter from turn end

2.41m (7.9ft)
•Five-meters from turn end

1.77m (5.8ft)

•All automatic starting and timing with full digital scoreboard

Strobe on each starting block

•Sixteen (16) adjacent lanes for warm-ups and cool downs

•Ample deck seating for athletes and coaches.

Concessions and swim shop in the Davis Natatorium lobby

Orientation:

•The NORTH ↑ Pool backs up to the Piper-Bass Student Center

The <u>SOUTH</u> ♥ Pool backs up to the Davis Natatorium and has the full-motion scoreboard

•Diving competition, Preliminaries and Finals for ALL five (5) UIL Districts competing at the Davis Natatorium will be

consolidated on Friday, January 22nd

•11-dive format

One-meter board only

•Five (5) voluntary and six (6) optional dives must be performed

- •ALL DIVERS MUST BE ENTERED INTO <u>BOTH</u> HY-TEK <u>AND</u> CLEAN ENTRIES IN ORDER TO PARICIPATE IN THIS MEET THERE CAN BE NO EXCEPTIONS!
- •All corrections, revisions or deletions must be competed in writing and in the hands of the Diving Referee <u>before</u> the scheduled start of competition
- •Warm-ups begin at 0900
- •Competition begins at 1030

Facility Rules, Regulations

Rules:

and Policies: •Athletes please self-screen for COVID symptoms before leaving home

- •Self-isolate if positive
- •The Competition Protocols and Procedures, posted throughout the facility, must be followed at all times
- •Masks must be worn at all times when not in the water
- Deck changing is prohibited
- •Two-piece swim wear is prohibited
- •The presence of cell phones, smart phones, iPads, etc. <u>anywhere</u> behind the starting blocks is prohibited at all times during competition
 - •Violators are subject to having their devices temporarily confiscated

•The 2020 – 2021 National Federation Swimming and Diving Rules will govern this meet

- •Photographers and videographers are specifically prohibited from the area immediately behind the starting blocks during competition
- •Parents and other spectators are not permitted on-deck at any time for any reason
- •Flash photography of any sort is expressly forbidden during competition
- •Standing in front of and / or leaning against the glass rails is expressly forbidden
- •Times noted on the scoreboard are never official and must not ever be regarded as such
- •All swimmers and divers are required to wear their approved uniforms and warm-ups
- •Hats, body or face painting, costumes, and / or props will not be allowed
- Organized cheers by school's teams will be allowed on deck in front of the designated seating area for each school
- •All spirit groups and Team Mascots must stay in the spectator area and will not be allowed on deck
- •Athletes and / or teams that violate these rules will be subject to disciplinary actions that could include disqualification from the competition.

Spectator Clear

Bag Policy: •Please review the graphic on page four (4)

Cell phone Restrictions:

•The presence and / or use of cell phones, and / or any other equipment capable of producing audio recordings, photographic or video images in locker rooms, rest rooms, changing areas or anywhere behind the starting blocks is strictly and specifically prohibited at all times

- •There are no exceptions to this prohibition
- Violators are subject to disqualification from the meet, disbarment from the facility and arrest

Swimmer Photographs

And Videos: •Each participating school is allowed one photographer on deck during competition – mask required

- •In the event such personnel are present, parents or guardians of swimmers under the age of 18 who do not wish to have photos or videos of their athletes made, are required to contact the Meet Director prior to the beginning of warmups.
- •Photographers and videographers are prohibited from the area immediately behind the starting blocks, and are also specifically prohibited from taking shots using flash during the start phase of *any* race.

Media Deck

Access:

•Access to the deck by the media is carefully controlled and members must pick up the necessary credentials from the

front office at the Davis Natatorium

•A signature will be required and the credentials must be returned to that same office on departure

Format: •Timed finals

Nominal 60 seconds between races

Entry

Restrictions: •Each swimmer may enter four events, no more than two of which may be individual events

•No school may enter more than four swimmers in any single individual event

•Each school is limited to one relay team per relay event





Relays:

- •Only the four (4) swimmers declared on the front of the relay card are permitted to report to the blocks and compete
- •If the swimmers are to be correctly noted in the Final Results, the order of swimming must also be specified.
- •Relay cards for the 200-yard Medley Relay must be turned in to the Official Scorer <u>not later than thirty (30) minutes</u> prior to the scheduled start of the meet.
- •Relay cards for the 200-yard Free Relay must be turned in to the Official Scorer not later than the start of the men's 500-yard freestyle.
- •Relay cards for the 400-yard Free Relay must be turned in to the Official Scorer not later than the start of the men's 100-yard backstroke.
- •Once relay cards have been turned in to the Official Scorer, no changes will be permitted and post-meet corrections or revisions cannot be made.

National

Time

Verification:

- •This meet has been approved by USA Swimming for NTV purposes, which means times achieved by properly <u>registered and entered</u> USA Swimming athletes can be loaded into the SWIMS National Database
- •In order for a time from a high school championship or season culminating meet to be entered into the USA Swimming (USA-S) National SWIMS Database, the athlete must be <u>currently</u> (2021) registered with USA-S <u>AND</u> the athlete's USA Swimming ID Number and legal name must be completely and accurately entered into the District 26-6A Championship Meet Manager Database
- •If done correctly, no further action by either the coach or the athlete is necessary
- •ALL swims involving the backstroke, butterfly and breaststroke will be observed by USA Swimming Certified Officials and exceptions to the technical rules will be noted to the NTV Officer on deck

•1200, Friday, January 15, 2021

Entry Procedures

- •Entries may be submitted ONLY by Hy-Tek Commlink file
- Hard copy must accompany
- •Each entry must include the swimmer's full name, swimmers school affiliation grade, and a seedtime
- •Entries received without a seedtime will be rejected

Advancers:

•The four (4) top finishing individual swimmers, divers and relay teams from each event will advance to the UIL Region VII Class 6-A Championships at this same venue, Girls on February 3rd and Boys on February 5th, 2021

Scratch

Rules:

- •High School Championship format
- Scratches are not permitted
- •Swimmers who fail to appear for any competition which they have entered will be disqualified from further competition
- Previous performances will not be nullified
- Failures to compete by reason of illness or injury are excepted.
- •An individual swimmer or relay team may withdraw from competition without penalty in any given event by declaring a false start
- •Declared false starts, however, <u>do</u> count as an event

Swimming Officials Please Make

Special Note:

- •All officials <u>must</u> be properly registered with Arbiter Sports for the 2020 2021 Season and have passed the current exam
 - •Officials not currently registered are not covered by NFHS Insurance and will not be assigned
- •The Meet Referee will make all deck assignments BEFORE the meet
- •Therefore, all officials who desire to be assigned to deck positions MUST notify the Meet Referee of their intentions and availability NOT LATER than 1800, Sunday, January 17th
- •Please submit your information to: rd.russ@yahoo.com
- •You WILL NOT be pre-assigned if your commitment and information are not submitted or not received by the deadline
- •Uniforms for deck officials will be as follows:
 - <u>PRELIMINARIES:</u> White collared shirts / blouses over khaki trousers, skirts, <u>Bermuda-length</u> shorts or capris (<u>NO JEANS OR FLIP-FLOPS PLEASE</u>)
 - •FINALS: Navy Blue collared shirts / blouses over khaki trousers, or skirts
- •Please report to the Walker second floor Conference Room at 0915 and again at 1415 to receive assignments

Spectator

Access:
•Spectators must enter the facility by the <u>Davis Natatorium front doors</u>

Coaches

Please NOTE: •Buses are *required* to unload their athletes at the front doors

- •Buses are required to park in the BAC Soccer Parking Lot behind the Davis Natatorium
- •Buses may move around the facility in order to re-load their athletes from the north end of the Walker Pool

Athlete, Coach, Official Access and Parking:

- •Athletes and Coaches are required to park in the soccer field lot behind the Davis Natatorium and enter the facility via the front doors of the Davis Natatorium marked **Coaches and Athletes Only!**
- •Officials are asked to park toward the north end of the Walker Pool and enter through the north doors marked **Officials Only**
