Facility:

- The Bill Walker Pool opened in October of 2019 and is part of the North East School District’s Blossom Athletic Center and is also known as the North East Stadium
- It is an indoor facility with two ten-lane SCY racing courses and off-deck spectator seating for 800
- The courses have been professionally certified IAW Article 104.2.2C(4) and the data are on file with USA Swimming. This competition will be conducted only in the **SOUTH** ↓ pool

•**Water depth** ↓:

•One-meter from start end	2.35m (7.7ft)	•Five-meters from start end	2.41m (7.9ft)
•One-meter from turn end	1.77m (5.8ft)	•Five-meters from turn end	1.77m (5.8ft)

•All automatic starting and timing with full digital scoreboards

•Strobe on each starting block

•Sixteen (16) adjacent lanes and the eight-lane Davis pool will be available for warm-ups and cool downs

•Ample deck seating for athletes and coaches.

•Concessions and swim shop in the Davis Natatorium lobby

•Parents are not be allowed on deck

•**Orientation:**

•The **NORTH** ↑ Pool backs up to the Piper-Bass Student Center

•The **SOUTH** ↓ Pool backs up to the Davis Natatorium and has the full-motion scoreboard

Bag Policy: •Please review the graphic on page four (4)

Cell phone

Restrictions: •The presence and / or use of cell phones, or any other equipment capable of producing audio recordings, photographic or video images in locker rooms, rest rooms or changing areas is strictly and specifically prohibited at all times

•There are no exceptions to this prohibition

•Violators are subject to disqualification from the meet, disbarment from the facility and arrest

•There may be one or more photographers and / or videographers on deck at this meet.

•In the event such personnel are present, parents or guardians of swimmers under the age of 18 who do not wish to have photos or videos of their athletes made, are required to contact the Meet Director prior to the beginning of warm-ups.

Meet Format:

•High School Teams competing in pre-seeded timed final competition

•Standard and modified high school individual events

•Maximum (slower than) times for all events and Minimum (faster than) qualifying times for six (6) events

•The Federation Whistle Start Procedure will be in use

•The Federation No-recall False Start Procedure will be in use

•Order of events and Time Standards on page four (4)

•Fly-over starts will be used, except for the backstroke and relay events

•Breaks will be taken only at the points noted in the Order of Events on page four (4)



Fly Over

- Starts:**
- In the interest of time, Meet Management reserves the right to employ Fly Over Starts should the number of entries warrant
 - If necessary, the matter will be outlined and explained at the Coaches' Meeting

Entry

- Restrictions:**
- This meet is open to all public and private High School teams who are members of the AAHSSL.
 - Individual swimmers may enter a maximum of four (4) events
 - No limit on the number of individual entries per team, per individual event
 - ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT A SEED TIME WILL NOT BE ENTERED INTO THE MEET

Qualifying

- Times:**
- There are maximum qualifying times (**2022** South Zone TISCA) for all events, please see page three (3)
 - There are minimum qualifying times on six (6) events, three girls and three boys, please see page four (4)
 - Swimmers must have at some time (lifetime best) achieved the minimum cut-off time for each of those events they choose to enter.
 - Entry times may be challenged
 - If a challenge results in an entry time being declared invalid, the swimmer will be disqualified from further participation in the meet
 - Any team accumulating three (3) invalid entries will be banned from further participation in the meet and their school's principal notified

- Rules:**
- The 2022 - 2023 National Federation of State High School Association Swimming and Diving Rules will apply
 - Swimmers will not be considered to be officially entered into the meet until actually stepping up on the starting platform or into the water, i.e., there will be no penalty for scratches or no-shows.
 - Nominal interval of 30 seconds between races

Entry

- Procedures:**
- Entries may be made **ONLY** via HY-TEK Commlink File
 - Hard copy **MUST** accompany
 - An "HYV" File for Team Manager is available on the das Schwimmen – San Antonio Web Site at www.aaaa-sa.org.

- E-Mail Entries:**
- You **must** submit your entries via e-mail to: Bill Spurgeon at: cbolle@neisd.net
 - The Commlink File must be *renamed* to clearly identify the entering team, the shorter the better
 - Athletes included in improperly identified Commlink Files (Cfile0X.cl2 or zfile00X.zip) will not be entered into the meet and any entry fees will not be refunded
 - Athletes **WILL NOT** be entered into the Meet Manager Database until the Meet Entry Report (hard copy) is received as an attachment to the e-mail or hand-delivered entries and all fees are paid.
 - Under no circumstances will entries be accepted via FAX
 - Please do not assume your entries have been received without confirmation

- Entry Deadline** •1200, Monday, November 7, 2022

- Entry fees:**
- \$10.00 per athlete IAW the AAHSSL Handbook
 - Checks payable to: **NEISD Aquatics**
 - Please include the name of the meet on the check
 - All entry fees must be paid prior to the start of the meet
 - If, for whatever reason, payment will be delayed, school must notify the Host and make arrangements with the Meet Director prior to the day of the meet
 - Teams who have not paid their entry fees or made satisfactory arrangements with the Meet Director will not be allowed to participate in the meet.
 - No late or deck entries will be permitted

Prohibited Bags

PROHIBITED ITEMS INCLUDE, BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO:

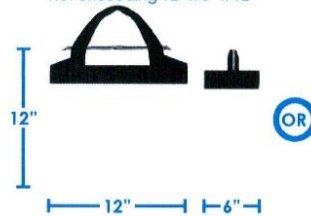
- All purses, bags or containers larger than a small clutch bag
- Backpacks
- Binocular case – Binoculars may be worn around the neck
- Briefcases
- Camera bags
- Cinch bags
- Computer bags
- Coolers
- Fanny packs

Approved Bags

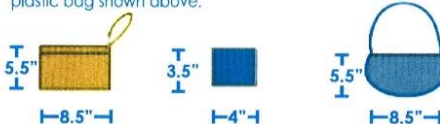
CLEAR TOTE
Plastic, vinyl or PVC – not exceeding 12" x 6" x 12"

PLASTIC STORAGE BAG
Clear, one (1) gallon, re-sealable



SMALL CLUTCH PURSE

Approximately the size of your hand, but absolutely no larger than 5.5" x 8.5" (see our small guide sheet) with or without a handle or strap. Can be carried separately or within an approved plastic bag shown above.



To enhance public safety, Blossom Athletic Center has modified its security policy by limiting the size and style of bags allowed into events.

An exception will be made for medically necessary items after proper inspection at a gate designated for this purpose. Please limit the number of items you bring to the stadium on event days.
