**Meet Site:** The Tex Robertson Natatorium located in the YMCA of the Highland Lakes in beautiful Burnet, Texas. 1601 S. Water St. Burnet, TX 78611.

**Facility:**

- \* 10 competition lanes with a separate warm down pool.
- Locker rooms and showers
- Coaches' and officials hospitality
- Fully automated 10 lane Colorado timing system
- Ample seating for competitors and spectators (We may access the gym for extra seating for swimmers if necessary - Please plan to have a parent or two to help monitor your swimmers in the gym.)
- Meet manager computer program will be used to conduct the meet.

**Schedule:** Warm-up at 9:00 a.m. (warm-up sessions will be assigned prior to the meet via e-mail)

Coach's Meeting @ 10:15 a.m.

Swimming will begin at 10:30 a.m.

2018-2019 National Federation Rules will apply.

**Scoring:** Standard Scoring: 1<sup>st</sup>-16<sup>th</sup>

**Points:** 20-17-16-15-14-13-12-11-9-7-6-5-4-3-2-1

**Relays:** Double Points

**Awards:** Trophy for 1<sup>st</sup> place Boys and Girls Teams

**Custom Awards:** Medals: 1<sup>st</sup> - 3<sup>rd</sup> (Every Event)

**Ribbons:** 4<sup>th</sup> - 10<sup>th</sup> (Every Event)

**Entry Limit:** Each swimmer may enter a maximum of four events.

No more than two may be individual events. Relay entries are limited to two per team per relay event. Only the first 4 swimmers from each team may contribute points toward their team score. Only the "A" relay will be scored. The first 500 swimmers will be entered into the meet.

Warm-up Procedures: You will be emailed warm-up schedule after all of the entries have been received.

- The warm-up will be general warm-up in all lanes.
- No sprinting or pace work is allowed during this period.
- No diving is allowed during the general warm-up.
- Swimmers must enter the water feet first in a cautious manner.
- During the last 10 minutes of warm-up, one-way dives will be allowed.
- Coaches will be responsible to make sure their team follows these warm-up rules.

## EXPLANATION/ DESCRIPTION OF THE COED RELAYS

**Witch Hat Relay** – First swimmer will perform a feet first entry from the block, swim a heads up 50, upon returning the first swimmer will exit the water and place the witch hat on the next swimmer. The second, third, and fourth swimmers will enter feet first from the deck. The race is complete when the fourth swimmer touches the pad at the end of the race.

**Broomstick Relay** – First swimmer will dive into the water from the deck, swim a 25 with at least one hand on the broom handle between the tape on the handle, exit the water at the end of their 25, and hand the broom off to the next competitor who will do the same. The fourth swimmer will finish the race by touching the pad with their hand.

**Sweatshirt Relay** – The first swimmer will start from the block with the sweatshirt on and all others will start from the deck. Each swimmer will dive in and swim a 25, exit the water to remove the shirt and pass it to the next competitor. The next competitor should have the sweatshirt on appropriately....ie.... head and arms in the correct places. The race is complete when the final swimmer contacts the pad at the end of their turn. Each relay may have one additional teammate on each end to help with the sweatshirt exchange.

**Frog Feet Relay** – All swimmers will start from the deck using a dive. Each competitor will wear fins for their leg of the race. In the event a fin falls off the competitor must stop and put the fin back on and then without advancing off of the bottom the swimmer will then continue their leg of the race. The second, third, fourth, and fifth swimmer may not begin their leg of the race until the previous swimmer exits the water completely. The first swimmer will swim a 25, second swimmer will swim a 75, the third swimmer will swim a 25, the fourth swimmer will swim a 75, and the final swimmer will swim a 50. The race is complete when the final swimmer touches the pad at the end of their leg of the race. **EACH RELAY TEAM WILL BRING THEIR OWN FINS FOR THIS RELAY.**
