Diving will be held in the deep well, Jan 26th, 2022.
Warm up at 4:00 pm, Dives start at 5:00 pm.
Psych Sheet will be emailed no later than January 21st.

Five (5) voluntary dives and six (6) optional dives must be performed. Dive sheets must be entered prior to the diving event.

Swimming will be held in the middle pool, Jan 26th, 2022.
Warm up at 5:00 pm, Coaches Meeting at 4:30 pm, Meet starts approximately at 6 pm
Psych Sheet will be emailed no later than January 21st.
Cancellations are due by the end of the coaches meeting. Heat sheets will be issued prior to meet.

Team Entry: NA

Only coaches, timers, and athletes allowed on deck behind starting blocks. No outside food or drinks are allowed.

Rules:

- *Except as may be noted elsewhere, the 2021 – 2022 National Federation Swimming, Diving and Water Polo Rules will apply.
- *Championship format, Finals only
- *A Meet Committee of five (5), appointed by the Meet Director (two officials, two non coaches), will be the final authority on issues referred to it under authority of the Federation Rules)
- *There will not be a 7A or 8A event before the meet this year.
- *The Federation Whistle Start Procedure will be in use at this meet
- *The Federation “No Recall” false start protocol will be in use at this meet

Cell phone Restrictions:

- The presence and / or use of cell phones, and any other equipment capable of producing audio recordings, photographic or video images in locker rooms, rest rooms or changing areas is strictly and specifically prohibited at all times
- There are no exceptions to this prohibition
- Violators are subject to disqualification from the meet, disbarment from the facility and arrest

Entry Restrictions:

- This meet is open only to 28-5A schools.
- Individual swimmers may enter a maximum of four (4) events, only two of which may be individual events
- 4 person limit on the number of individual entries per team, per individual event, per gender
- Each team may enter only one relay team per relay event per gender. Pickup relay cards when you enter building. All relay cards are due by 5:30 pm (changes may be made 30 minutes prior to actual relay if needed).

Format:

- Order of events (see schedule)
- Championship format with multiple heats and each individual event advancing top 6 to Regionals plus top 4 relays.
- A break will be taken only at the points noted in the Order of Events

Relays:

- Only the four (4) swimmers declared on the front of the relay card are permitted to report to the blocks and compete
- If the swimmers are to be correctly noted in the Finals Results, the order of swimming must also be specified
- Once relay cards have been turned in to the Official Scorer, no changes will be permitted 30 minutes prior to the event and post-meet corrections cannot be made except for illness and injury
 - Top 4 relay teams advance to regionals.

Scratch Rules:

- High School Championship Format
- Scratches are permitted once meet starts
- Previous performances will not be nullified
- Failures to compete for reason of illness or injury are accepted as long as the Meet Referee is notified
- An individual swimmer or relay team may withdraw from competition without penalty in any given event by declaring a false start to the Meet Referee
- Declared false starts **do** count as an event

- Meet starts at Conclusion of the Diving competition
