- Facility:**
- The Bill Walker Pool opened in October of 2019 and is part of the North East School District’s Blossom Athletic Center and is AKA as the North East Stadium
 - It is an indoor facility with two ten-lane SCY racing courses and off-deck spectator seating for 800
 - The course has been professionally certified IAW Article 104.2.2C(4) and the data are on file with USA Swimming. This competition will be conducted only in the **SOUTH** ↓ pool

- All automatic starting and timing with full digital scoreboards
 - Sixteen (16) adjacent lanes and the eight-lane Davis pool will be available for warm-ups and cool downs
 - Ample deck seating for athletes and coaches.
 - Concessions and swim shop in the Davis Natatorium lobby
 - Spectators may not bring food or drink into the facilities
 - Parents are not be allowed on deck
 - Orientation:**
 - The **NORTH** ↑ Pool backs up to the Piper-Bass Student Center
 - The **SOUTH** ↓ Pool backs up to the Davis Natatorium and has the full-motion scoreboard
- Rules:** •The 2023 - 2024 National Federation Swimming and Diving Rules will govern this meet
- Spectator Clear Bag Policy:** •Please review the graphic on page three (3)
- Cell phone Restrictions:**
- The presence and / or use of cell phones, and / or any other equipment capable of producing audio recordings, photographic or video images in locker rooms, rest rooms, changing areas or anywhere behind the starting blocks is strictly and specifically prohibited at all times
 - There are no exceptions to these prohibitions
 - Violators are subject to disqualification from the meet, disbarment from the facility and arrest

Photographs
And Videos:**

- There may be one or more photographers and / or videographers on deck at this meet.
 - Each participating school is allowed two photographers / videographers on deck during competition.
- In the event such personnel are present, parents or guardians of swimmers under the age of 18 who do not wish to have photos or videos of their athletes made, are required to contact the Meet Director prior to the beginning of warm-ups.
- Photographers and videographers are strongly encouraged to stay out of the area immediately behind the starting blocks, but if present, they are specifically prohibited from taking shots during the start phase of any race.

Entry fees:

- \$10.00 per athlete IAW the League Handbook
 - Checks payable to: **NEISD**
 - Please include the name of the meet on the check
 - All entry fees must be paid prior to the start of the meet
 - If, for whatever reason, payment will be delayed, school must notify the Host and make arrangements with the Meet Director prior to the day of the meet
 - Teams who have not paid their entry fees or made satisfactory arrangements with the Meet Director will not be allowed to participate in the meet.
 - No late or deck entries will be permitted

**Entry
Restrictions:**

- This meet is open to all AAHSSL Member Schools
- Entries will be capped at 400 individual swimmers - Teams will not be split!•Each swimmer may enter five (5) events
- No school may enter more than four swimmers in any single individual event

Format:

- Timed Finals
- No diving or relays
- The National Federation no-recall false start and whistle starting procedures will be in use
- No breaks will be taken

**Qualifying
Times:**

- There are MAXIMUM Qualifying Times on all events – please see page two (2)
- Swimmers entering any one of the events must have never achieved the specified time

**Entry
Procedures**

- Entries may be submitted ONLY by Hy-Tek Commlink file
- Hard copy must accompany
- Each entry must include the swimmer’s full name, swimmers school affiliation grade, and a seedtime
- Entries received without a seedtime will be rejected
- There is an HYV File posted on the Specified High School Meets Page at www.aaaa-sa.org and the AAHSSL Page at www.alamoareaaquatics.com, which contain the meet setup and maximum time standards.

Scratch Rules:

- Individual swimmers or relay teams are not considered to be officially entered into an event until actually stepping up on the block or into the water, as the case may be, i.e., there is no penalty for scratching or being a NO SHOW.

PROHIBITED ITEMS INCLUDE, BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO:

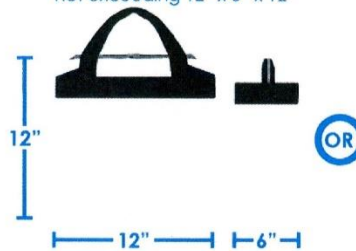
- All purses, bags or containers larger than a small clutch bag
- Backpacks
- Binocular case – Binoculars may be worn around the neck
- Briefcases
- Camera bags
- Cinch bags
- Computer bags
- Coolers
- Fanny packs
- Luggage of any kind



Approved Bags

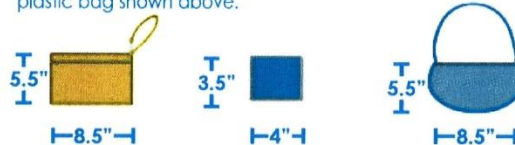
CLEAR TOTE
Plastic, vinyl or PVC –
not exceeding 12" x 6" x 12"

PLASTIC STORAGE BAG
Clear, one (1) gallon,
re-sealable



SMALL CLUTCH PURSE

Approximately the size of your hand, but absolutely no larger than 5.5" x 8.5" (see our small guide sheet) with or without a handle or strap. Can be carried separately or within an approved plastic bag shown above.
