Facility: •The Bill Walker Pool opened in October of 2019 and is part of the North East School District's Blossom Athletic

Center and is AKA as the North East Stadium

•It is an indoor facility with two ten-lane SCY racing courses and off-deck spectator seating for 800

•The course has been professionally certified IAW Article 104.2.2C(4) and the data are on file with USA Swimming.

This competition will be conducted <u>only</u> in the **SOUTH ♥** pool

•Water depth  $\Psi$ :

•One-meter from start end 2.35m (7.7ft) •Five-meters from start end 2.41m (7.9ft) •One-meter from turn end 1.77m (5.8ft) •Five-meters from turn end 1.77m (5.8ft)

•All automatic starting and timing with full digital scoreboards

•Sixteen (16) adjacent lanes and the eight-lane Davis pool will be available for warm-ups and cool downs

•Ample deck seating for athletes and coaches.

Concessions and swim shop in the Davis Natatorium lobby
Spectators may not bring food or drink into the facilities

Parents are not be allowed on deck

Orientation:

•The <u>NORTH</u> ↑ Pool backs up to the Piper-Bass Student Center

•The <u>SOUTH</u> ♥ Pool backs up to the Davis Natatorium and has the full-motion scoreboard

Rules: •The 2023 - 2024 National Federation Swimming and Diving Rules will govern this meet

**Cell phone** 

Restrictions: •The presence and / or use of cell phones, and / or any other equipment capable of producing audio recordings,

photographic or video images in locker rooms, rest rooms, changing areas <u>or anywhere behind the starting blocks</u> is strictly and specifically prohibited at all times

•There are no exceptions to these prohibitions

•Violators are subject to disqualification from the meet, disbarment from the facility and arrest

#### **Swimmer Photographs**

**And Videos:** •There may be one or more photographers and / or videographers on deck at this meet.

•Each participating school is allowed two photographers / videographers on deck during competition.

•In the event such personnel are present, parents or guardians of swimmers under the age of 18 who do not wish to have photos or videos of their athletes made, are required to contact the Meet Director prior to the beginning of warm-ups.



 Photographers and videographers are strongly encouraged to stay out of the area immediately behind the starting blocks, but if present, they are specifically prohibited from taking shots during the start phase of any race.

•Each swimmer may enter five (5) events

•No school may enter more than four swimmers in any single individual event

 Standard High School Timed Final Events Format:

No diving or relays

•The National Federation no-recall false start and whistle starting procedures will be in use

•15-minute break after the 50-yard Freestyle required by rule

Qualifying

Times: •There are MAXIMUM Qualifying Times on all events – please see page two (2)

•Swimmers entering any one of the events must have never achieved or exceeded the specified time

**Procedures** •Entries may be submitted ONLY by Hy-Tek Commlink file

Hard copy must accompany

Each entry <u>must</u> include the swimmer's full name, swimmers school affiliation <u>grade</u>, and a seedtime

•Entries received without a seedtime will be rejected


Officials: •All deck officials must be *currently* (2023 - 2024), properly registered with NFHS and have passed the current exam
